Agenda Item: Office Updates given by Director Corrine Duncan

- State BOE Conference will be held virtually on March 14-15.
- The hiring process has begun for new employees.
- As part of a county-wide initiative, the Interchange Building will be outfitted with an alert system called ALERTUS to aid in communications during emergencies.
- Staff has submitted an updated schedule to the Board to be approved at the next meeting.
- They will need to approve the new budget this Spring (2/8?)
- Mr. Aceto asked for an update on plans to improve the process for appointing election judges. Jake said they are working on a better process and it will involve newly developed Precinct Profile Reports.

Agenda Item: Preliminary Hearing

- Holt Pearce appeared before the Board to challenge the voter registration of Keith Ginsburg.
- He submitted evidence to demonstrate that Mr. Ginsburg has moved to South Carolina.
- County Attorney was present and clarified that their goal at this preliminary hearing was to determine if there is probable cause that the voter is ineligible. If that is found, there will be a full hearing where the voter can make a rebuttal.
- Jake moved that they proceed to a formal hearing. Aceto seconded and the motion was approved.
- The hearing will probably be at the next Board meeting on 2/8.

In other news, Liz Carpenter will be leaving the Board and hopes to have a successor before the next meeting. No details were given.
